## Explanation

This explains the functional steps within the sequence. For all the other XML details please refer to [Formats and syntax](#)

- `Handles.SetSourceHandleFromHandle("groupHandleUN=20")` marks the group with usernumber 20 as sourceHandle for the next operation
- `Handles.ConfirmDelete()` deletes the previously selected handle (the group UN20)
