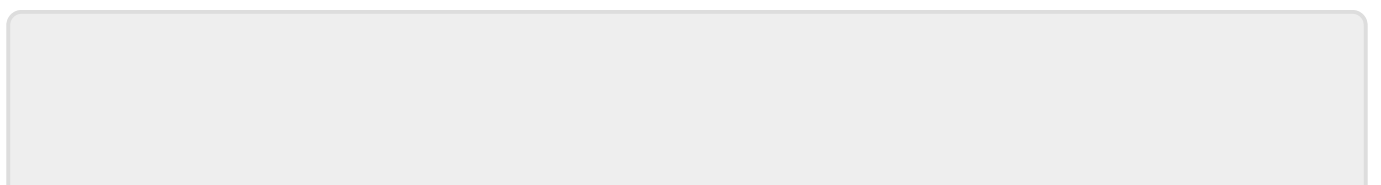
Explanation
