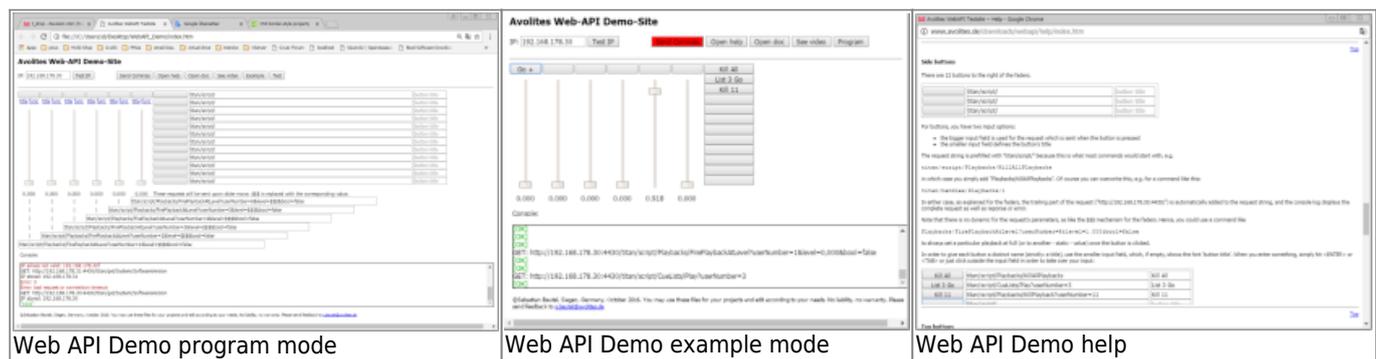
# Web API Demo
